Monday

Soccer Skills Clinic

Students will be provided with individualized soccer skills training by the coaches at vonEgypt Soccer Academy founded by SDSC alumni and professional soccer player, Nick vonEgypt. This clinic is designed to help students at any level improve their skills on the soccer field! Each student will receive needs-based, personalized, dynamic and fun training. Students should bring sneakers/gym shoes to school.



Grades: K-3 (Minimum 10 students; Maximum 15 students)

"Mad Science: Secret Agent Lab" (Grades 4-6)



Calling all agents! This program is part forensics and part "spy science." Step into the shoes of a detective and uncover the science involved in evidence gathering and analysis. Students will create, collect, and analyze evidence and discover what skills are necessary to be a crime scene lab technician. They examine clues and get hot on the trail of a culprit, and then connect the dots using science to help solve a crime in a hands-on investigation. From edible messages and decoding clues, students also will have the opportunity to check out some of the skills that spies must master in a hands-on journey into the world of espionage.

This program brings together the disciplines of singing, acting, and dancing as the students work together to create their own theatrical production. Students will learn stage presence, projection, diction, choreography, set design, sound, lighting and more. This Spring the Musical Theater Program will be presenting "Seussical the Musical." Auditions for performance roles have been completed and the show has been cast. Opportunities for stage crew will be announced shortly.

Soccer Skills Clinic

Sew Happy: Llama Drama

"Llama Drama" is inspired by the art and culture of South America and hand painted in watercolors. Students will begin by practicing stitches on a round mug rug, and then they will have fun sewing, stuffing and decorating a llama "stuffie" and blanket. The final part of this project is a llama/cactus keychain with interchangeable accessories where the students will enjoy dressing their felt friends with sunglasses, bows, hats and scarves.

Sprouts Garden Club

Students will learn all about starting vegetable plants from seeds! They will begin a variety of plants indoors for the Project Nourish School Garden including peppers, tomatoes, broccoli, cauliflower and cucumbers. Weather permitting, students will also plant cool weather seeds directly in the garden such as lettuce, radishes, kale and potatoes.

Grades: 4-8 (Minimum 5 students)

LEGO Club

This is a fun, hands-on, social program where we encourage children to use their imaginations and put their skills to use! Each session will have a theme, free play, and some will have games and group challenges. This is the second of three sessions of LEGO Club that will be offered this School Year.

Grades: K-2 (Maximum 15 students)

Martial Arts



Students will learn self-discipline, improve their focus, and strengthen their physical abilities through the ancient martial art of Taekwondo. The classes taught by Telesco's Martial Arts will focus on blocks, kicks, punches, strikes, balance, self-defense and even weapon techniques (wooden swords). Martial arts is an excellent tool for physical fitness and character development alike!
