We don't want you to lose any of the valuable skills you have learned to date. Therefore, I've planned an assignment for you during the summer to keep those skills sharp so you'll be ready once September starts!

Reading and Writing

This year, we have teamed up to bring you a great summer reading and writing adventure! Please see the attached Google Slides for your reading adventure!

Math Skills Practice: You are to complete your Simple Solutions Math workbook. You are required to complete the entire book by the first day of school. You will have plenty of time if you complete one page each weekday of the summer. *There will be a QUIZ on the skills and concepts in your Math Summer Solutions when you return to school in September.* We will be learning multiplication facts in third grade. It is important that addition and subtraction facts are in tip top shape at the beginning of third grade. Mrs. Barber's website has a variety of math links to give you some fun math skills practice. Take just 10 minutes a day to keep those skills sharp.

SCHOOL UNIFORM 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

BOYS IN K- 8

- White dress shirt (oxford for Grades K-8) and plaid school tie
- Green V-neck sweater vest or pullover V-neck sweater with school name
- Green dress slacks (purchased at Li'l Darlings)
- Black/Brown belt and dark socks
- Black or Brown supportive shoe with Shoe laces, strap, or Velcro (NO slip on or boat shoes)

GIRLS IN K - 3

- Green Plaid uniform jumper and white oxford blouse
- Green or Black knee socks/tights
- Black or Brown supportive shoes with shoe laces, Velcro, or strap (NO slip-on or boat shoes)

SUMMER UNIFORM K-8

- Green shorts (no more than an inch above the knee) with belt or beige skort (*from Li'L Darling Shoppe*) for girls
- White polo shirt with school logo
- White crew socks that reach the ankle
- Black or Brown supportive shoes with shoe laces, Velcro or strap (NO slip-on or boat shoes)

PLEASE NOTE: Uniform SNEAKERS for Gym – WHITE or BLACK only with NO color

NOTE: PLEASE USE PERMANENT MARKER TO WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON EVERY ARTICLE OF CLOTHING AS WELL AS LUNCH BOX, BACKPACK and PENCIL BOX.

THIRD GRADE SUPPLY LIST: Please bring in on the first day of school!

- Ear-buds or headset for computers (in some kind of bag/pouch with name)
- 3 two-pocket folders (one each: green, red, and yellow)
- 2 boxes of tissues in September
- 2 boxes of tissues in January
- 1 roll paper towels
- 2 packages of wipes: one baby wipe and one disinfectant wipe
- 1 pencil box (not pouch). The box should be CLEAR and 5 1/2 inches by 8 1/2 inches and must have a **continuous supply** of the following items. (Monitor the box and refill as needed each night.)
 - #2 Ticonderoga pencils. No fancy, decorative pencils allowed. The children are to start each day with at least 5 sharpened pencils. **Note: No pencil sharpeners are to come to school.**
 - 1 Glue stick
 - 1 box of 24 crayons.
 - 1 **six-inch** plastic ruler with inches and centimeters. (Do not bring in 12 inch rulers)
 - 1 safety scissor
 - large eraser with name in ink on side
 - Expo dry erase markers – one needed daily (You can keep rest at home until needed.)
 - red pen

Paper and Notebooks: Notebooks and control lined paper are purchased through the school.

Please send in **\$25.00** fee to cover the cost of: *3 notebooks, 1 math notebook, 2 writing tablets, and a homework assignment planner.* Please send in cash or check payable to St. Denis-St. Columba School. There will only be an additional fee if notebooks are lost, damaged or filled up during the school year.

ART Supplies

- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 roll of clear packing tape (preferably Heavy Duty)
- 1 box of pencils
- *OPTIONAL* Art smock labeled (large t-shirt, no buttons, sealed in a labeled ziplock)
