UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS 2017-2018

Boys Winter Uniform

White oxford dress shirt and plaid school tie

Green V-neck sweater vest with school name or Green pullover V-neck sweater with school name Green dress slacks, black or brown belt

Dark socks, black or brown supportive shoes with laces, strap, or Velcro

Girls Winter Uniform

Green plaid drop waist jumper with white blouse (Peter Pan collar)

Green or black knee socks or tights, black or brown supportive <u>shoes with laces, strap, or Velcro</u> Green cardigan sweater with school name

NO large, colorful hair accessories. Only one STUD earring is allowed in each ear. <u>Please check</u> the handbook for more details regarding dress code.

Boys and Girls Summer Uniform

Green shorts (no more than 1 inch above the knee) with brown or black belt

White polo shirt with school logo

White crew socks - must reach the anklebone

Black or brown supportive shoes with laces, strap, or Velcro

Uniform sneakers for Physical Education are WHITE or BLACK only with NO color.

NOTE: <u>PLEASE USE PERMANENT MARKER TO WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON EVERY</u> ARTICLE OF CLOTHING, AS WELL AS LUNCH BOX AND BACKPACK and PENCIL BOX.

2nd Grade Supplies

- 1. 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2. 3 boxes of tissues
- 3. 1 package of construction paper: (80 lb weight preferred) bright colors
- 4. 4 dry erase markers (black, fine point only)
- 5. 3, 2-pocket folders with *prongs* inside (one green, one yellow, and one red)
- 6. Clear contact paper to keep at home for covering SOFT COVER workbooks.

Second graders are required to have 1 pencil box (not pouch). The box should be **CLEAR** and $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches by $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

The supply-pencil box should have a continuous supply of the following items. (<u>This means</u> that you must monitor the box and refill as needed - The children will be instructed to bring the box home each night.)

- #2 <u>Ticonderoga</u> pencils. <u>No fancy, decorative pencils allowed.</u> The children are to start <u>each day</u> with at least 5 sharpened pencils.
- 1 (White Magic Rub) pencil eraser. These erase better than the pink erasers.
- 1 <u>Crossover</u> pencil grip (no substitutions)
- 1 Glue stick
- 1 box of 24 crayons.
- 1 six inch plastic ruler with inches and centimeters.
- 1 safety scissor
- 1 <u>yellow</u> highlighter
- 1 Bic 4-color retractable Ballpoint Pen
- <u>Earbuds</u> (nothing big and complicated, please) for computers (in zip lock bag with name) their ear buds are kept in their supply box.

To hang work on the walls, donations of Scotch Removable Mounting Putty (or similar brand) are greatly appreciated!

Art Supplies for Grades K-5
