MATH SUMMER SOLUTIONS is Required for ALL students! (Last Chance for a Discount!)

We expect ALL our students to purchase the Common Core MATH SUMMER SOLUTIONS, a program that helps to reinforce children's math skills over the summer. Ongoing practice ensures retention of all the math skills and concepts learned. The lessons are designed to be completed three times per week for ten weeks. Each book contains 30 lessons along with answers designed for self-checking. The cost of each book is \$12.00 and will be shipped directly to the school. There will be no shipping/handling fee or sales tax if you order online with the school code before Sunday, JUNE 3, 2018. After that date each book will cost \$14.99. Other resource books are also available if you are interested. Only the MATH is REQUIRED! 
