Our Walk-a-thon will take place after lunch and will follow a route on the school campus. After a morning of learning, students will

have a fun school-spirit-filled afternoon walking for their school! After the Walk-a-thon students will enjoy a treat together to celebrate. It's our last Fall fundraiser and the only one that involves direct student participation.

## **Walk-a-thon Prizes**

- 1. INDIVIDUAL PRIZES: Each student will receive one NUT Award (No Uniform Today Award) for every \$50 collected by Monday, October 28, 2019.
- 2. CLASS PRIZES: The class in the upper hall (Grades 4-8) and in the lower hall (Grades K-3) that raises the highest average donation per child will receive a Class NUT Day and an Ice Cream Party.
- 3. WHOLE SCHOOL PRIZES: If we reach a goal of \$15,000, we will designate additional 5 FREE NUT Days- one week of NUT Davs for all!
- 4. WHOLE SCHOOL PRIZES: If we reach a goal of \$20,000 we will have a "Half Day of Play" which includes another NUT day and an entire afternoon of recess activities!

## NO BUSING - Wednesday, October 9th

Please note that there will be **NO Busing** for Wappingers and Arlington on Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>. Parents are encouraged to carpool to ease traffic congestion. Please observe the following procedures:

**Drop Off:** Please pull forward as far as possible in the bus lane in front of the school. Students should exit vehicles and enter front of school. For the safety of the students, parking and walking students to the door is not permitted due to the number of moving cars on the premises.
