

# Uniform Requirements 2023-2024

### Winter Uniform

#### Boys

White oxford dress shirt and plaid school tie

Green V-neck sweater vest with school name **or** Green pullover V-neck sweater with school name  
Green dress slacks, black or brown belt

**Dark socks**, black or brown **supportive shoes** with laces, strap, or Velcro

#### Girls

Green plaid drop-waist jumper with white blouse (Peter Pan collar)

Green or black knee socks or tights, black or brown supportive shoes with laces, strap, or Velcro  
Green cardigan sweater with school name

**No large or colorful hair accessories.** Only one STUD earring is allowed in each ear. Please check the handbook for more details regarding dress code.

### Summer Uniform

#### Boys and girls

Green shorts (no more than 1 inch above the knee) with brown or black belt. Khaki skort for girls. White polo shirt with school logo

**White** crew socks - must reach the ankle bone

Black or brown **supportive shoes** with laces, strap, or Velcro

Uniform sneakers for Physical Education are **WHITE** or **BLACK** only with **NO** color.

NOTE: PLEASE USE PERMANENT MARKER TO WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON EVERY ARTICLE OF CLOTHING AS WELL AS LUNCH BOX, BACKPACK and PENCIL CASE, WATER BOTTLES, ETC.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Supplies

1. 1 of each: box of tissues, roll of paper towels, package of baby wipes
2. 1 set of Rosary beads
3. **#2 Ticonderoga pencils only.** NOTE: Each student should start every day of school with **5 sharpened pencils. No manual/hand held pencil sharpeners are allowed in class.**
4. 1 of each: good quality eraser, glue stick, safety scissor, plastic ruler with inches and centimeters, red pen, green pen
5. 1 box of crayons - No twist crayons. Please cover the box of crayons with the clear contact paper, or you can purchase a plastic crayon box container. It doesn't take long for the cardboard boxes to fall apart!
6. **Headset** for computers: Please have them in a labeled bag/pouch.
7. 4, 2-pocket folders (one each: green, red, blue, yellow, and purple) The inexpensive paper folders are perfect; you will be covering them with clear contact paper for reinforcement. I will have subject and name labels for the folders in September.
8. Clear contact paper to keep at home for covering SOFT - COVER workbooks and pocket folders.
9. 1 Zip-It Half and Half pencil case - or a similar soft sided, multi pocket pencil case.
  - The pencil case will go home each night with your child; **please make sure that the supplies are regularly replenished.**

### Fees:

**School supply fee of \$30.00** is due on the first day of school. This fee covers tablet paper, notebooks, Social Studies Weekly subscription, etc.

**Sacramental Fee of \$30.00** for Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

**Art Supplies:** Please have art supplies separate from the grade 2 supplies.

### **IXL Summer Boost for Math and Language Arts**

Each student will have Math and Language Arts Summer Boost assignments posted in their IXL account. This will help solidify student understanding of key concepts and make sure they are ready to start Second Grade! Each Summer Boost assignment is composed of **20 skill lessons**; these cover topics that the students should be familiar with in their present grade level. The program is adaptive; if the student gets a question wrong there is instruction to let the student know what the correct answer was and why. As students answer the questions their SMART Score grows. Students should work for a SMART Score of 90-100 on each assignment. Students may choose to do the assignments on any days they wish. ***Student are also expected to work on their personal "Step into the Arena" skills.*** All IXL assignments need to be completed by August 15<sup>th</sup>. This will allow for the system to be set up for next year and give the students a break to end the summer.

All summer assignments will receive a grade on the first quarter report card.
