### Thank you for your patience!

WE THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE as we continue to iron out the scheduling kinks and troubleshoot the new technology. Here are the tasks the SDSC Team is prioritizing:



- We've upgraded to the maximum capacity WIFI service that Optimum offers. Now we are ensuring that the signal strength is strong, especially in the areas of the building we have been repurposed as classrooms (e.g. gym).
- We believe that the Zoom connectivity issues at SDSC are resolved. There are three computers in every room that have to work in sync both through hardware and software in order to deliver synchronous learning both at home and school. Next week we are going to closely monitor the classrooms to smooth out the "kinks"
- We have installed lavalier microphones so that teacher audio is more audible during Zoom calls. We will continue to monitor audio transmissions to ensure students can hear at home.
- The teachers and the administration have used this week to experiment with Class Schedules, Zoom Meetings and breaks in an effort to create the best framework for each grade to simultaneously address in-person and remote learning. We are going to continue to test options this week. Our goal is to have somewhat permanent schedules for each grade in place by the end of the week.
- The administration is assisting the faculty with creating digital learning materials to bridge the gap until all of the textbooks and workbooks are delivered to the school. We are also setting up accounts for digital resources and textbooks for students. Teachers will provide logon information as soon as these materials are available.

### Home Remote Learning Issues

This week we have helped troubleshoot a number of technology issues at home that are not related to the technology at SDSC. Here are some helpful tips:

- If your screen is freezing, audio is intermittent or images are fuzzy, the problem is most likely originating with your internet service provider. Be aware that the community as a whole is using much more bandwidth so providers are reporting occasional outages or degraded service. Unfortunately there is nothing you can do about these situations, except wait it out.
- Consider upgrading your internet service if possible. Upgrading your upload rates/capacity will greatly improve watching videos and live streaming.



- Limit the number of devices actively using your bandwidth at the same time while your child is remote learning. The more devices (phones, tablets, computers, streaming television, etc. using your internet service at the same time, the less bandwidth that will be available to any one device.
- If a link the teacher has provided for Zoom, YouTube or other internet-based resource is being blocked, check your firewall settings on your computer and/or modem. A security setting is likely blocking the site.

### Car and Bus Transportation

- **Transportation Notes:** Please send in a **written** note regarding the method of transportation your child will take home, and anytime you need to make a change to that transportation method. You may send in a “standing note” one such as, “Joe will be a pickup unless otherwise notified.” Please do NOT call or email changes unless it’s an absolute emergency.
- **Car Rider Pickup Sign:** Please put a LARGE sign in your car window with your child(ren’s) LAST NAME and GRADE legibly written in BIG BOLD letters. The signs will help our staff more safely and efficiently direct students to their respective vehicles.
- **Car Rider Line:** Vehicles must line up in front of church (enter through ACME). PLEASE DO NOT use the entrance off of Route 82. THIS LANE IS FOR BUSES ONLY.



### Emergency Contact Cards

All students will bring home on Monday an Emergency Contact Card. Please complete one per family and return it to school as soon as possible. Remote students can return their cards during any scheduled material pickup or drop-off day.

The Faculty and Administration have decided to postpone our virtual Back to School Night to a date later in September. We want to make sure that we have resolved any remaining issues regarding technology, schedules, etc. so that we can give our families the most complete information about the 2020-21 School Year. Thank you again for your continued understanding.
