## PRIORITY ENROLLMENT BEGINS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8th

There are two steps that families **MUST** complete to re-enroll all returning students.

- ① Complete the re-enrollment verification through TADS and pay the \$100 priority registration fee for each child.
- ② Complete and return to school district transportation forms *even if your child never takes the bus,* which will be emailed to each family on Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup>!

Both steps must be completed no later than Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup> in order to receive priority enrollment.

#### **TADS Re-Enrollment Verification**

All families with children eligible to re-enroll for the 2021-22 school year will receive an email from TADS with a link to re-enroll. Follow the link, carefully review the information in the re-enrollment module for accuracy and pay the \$100 priority registration fee for each child to complete the first part of the re-enrollment process. If you do not see the email in your inbox, please check your junk/spam folder. #### **Transportation Forms**

SDSC will email public school district transportation forms to all families who are eligible for bus transportation. *These forms must be completed and returned to the office even if your child never takes the bus!* Every student must be assigned to a bus route for emergency purposes. ### Priority Registration ENDS February 26th

Applications for new students have outpaced our current classroom capacities. You must enroll for the 2021-22 School Year **on or before February 26**<sup>th</sup> in order to have priority placement in the grade level. If financial circumstances prevent you from completing the enrollment by the deadline, please notify the School Office immediately. *Once the priority period for re-enrollment ends, available spaces will be offered to new applicants*.

### **URGENT: Financial Assistance for for the 2021-22 School Year**



All families eligible for renewal of financial assistance were sent an email on February 2<sup>nd</sup> to **reapply for aid for the 2021-22 School Year**. To be considered for a renewal, you must complete the requalifying application online using the link provided in e-mail, pay the financial aid application fee, and submit all required documents. *Financial aid is awarded on a "first-come, first-served"* basis. **Awards are already being allocated**. Complete your financial aid application immediately.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

### **Chromebook Care**



We are fortunate as a school to have enough Chromebooks to be able loan them to students who need a device at home. Unfortunately, we are seeing problems with some of the loaned devices due to misuse and improper care. Parents/guardians are responsible for the care of all loaned devices. Charges will be assessed for damaged, dirty or broken devices. In most cases the damage is preventable. Most problems are caused by consumption of food/drinks while

using the devices. Help us keep our devices in good working order! No Chromebook should be out during snack or lunch time. The Chromebooks are to be used ONLY for learning purposes and not for personal use or entertainment!

#### Attendance on ZOOM classes in the Afternoon

It has come to my attention that some students are not signing on to ZOOM in the afternoon or are signing on, but are not present or participating. This is a reminder that <u>all videos must be on during class time</u>, and all students must be in full view of the camera during class time or they will be considered absent during that time. The entire face of the student must be visible on the ZOOM!

#### Students with their Chromebooks and Devices

All devices need to be fully charged for class each day whether the student is home or in school. PLEASE NOTE that going forward all students, must have <u>two fully-charged devices available to them</u> when they are taking a test remotely. This is so that the teacher can view the students as they are taking the test and can assist them as needed.

## You could be eligible for Covid Tuition Assistance!

Has Covid-19 impacted your family financially in anyway? You could be eligible to receive a one-time award from The Inner City Scholarship Fund to assist you with tuition. The criteria for an award is fairly broad and includes items such as increased childcare expenses, reduction in income (reduced hours, furlough, etc.), expenses for internet access/technology, Covid related medical expenses, costs associated with caring for an infected or quarantined person, etc. Awards will be made to eligible families until the funds are depleted.
