SCHOOL and GRADUATION Pictures - Monday, April 26th and Tuesday, April 27th!



The ADNY Health and Safety Task Force has approved the taking of individual student and graduate pictures. In order to take school pictures, the photography must be done outdoors, will only be conducted once per cohort, and students will maintain an appropriate social distance between each other and the photographer. You received an email with Pre-Paid purchase information.

Please NOTE the following:

- All students must be in **FULL Winter Uniforms for their pictures**. No NUT awards may be used on picture days.
- Students in Grades K-1 will be photographed on Monday, April 26th along with students in the **GREEN COHORT.**
- Students in the GOLD COHORT, and anyone in Kindergarten or Grade 1 who was absent the previous day, will be photographed on Tuesday, April 27th.
- Per ADNY policy, fully remote students may only attend a photography session if they bring proof of a negative Covid PCR test.
- There will be no make-up picture days this year due to the time restraints of the remaining school year.
- The Class of 2021 will be photographed in their own graduate caps and gowns, which they received last week. Please be sure they are wrinkle-free and brought into school the day of pictures. They will not be able to share caps and gowns with their classmates. Students are responsible for their caps and gowns until graduation!

NUTTY Friday – April 30th!

This Friday and the next are NUTTY Fridays! (No Uniform Today – Thank You Fridays!) All students at home and in school will be permitted to attend classes without their school uniform on these NUTTY days.

FRIENDLY REMINDER: NUT DAY clothing must comply with the rules in the SDSC Parent-Student Handbook. 
