

Summer Uniforms – Monday, May 17th

Remember that all school polo shirts are to be neatly tucked (not folded under) into their shorts/skorts at all times.

IMPORTANT REMINDER to CAR RIDERS!

Please be sure that whoever is picking up your children at the end of the school has a LARGE SIGN with BOLD LETTERS placed in the front or side window of their vehicle. It must contain the last name of the student(s) being picked up. The signs are critical to the dismissal process as they help us safely and quickly place students in the vehicles. MAP Assessments Take Place Week of May 17th and 24th

SDSC students will continue to take their final Spring NWEA MAP Growth assessments in Reading, Language and Math over the next two weeks.

Things to Know About MAP Assessments

- Please be sure that your child is on-time and fully rested so that they able to concentrate and do their best.
- HYBRID students will take assessments on days when they are at school in person.
- **FULLY REMOTE Students** will meet Sr. Kathleen on Zoom using the following link: https://zoom.us/j/98627201648?pwd=QXBlc1lpMFpHekdVNDlqNk9kTFpUdz09
- Fully remote students tentatively will meet Sr. Kathleen on ZOOM on the following days this week:
 - o Grades 6-7 at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 20th
 - o Grades 3-4 at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, May 21st
 - o Grades K-2 at 9:15 a.m. on Friday, May 21st
- Fully Remote Students will need TWO DEVICES: a device for taking the assessment (e.g. laptop, desktop or Chromebook) AND a Zoom capable device (e.g. phone, tablet, additional laptop or Chromebook). A parent/adult must be available to support as needed during designated testing times.
- Following the testing period, you will receive a Family Report showing a summary of this year's assessments so that you can observe how your child performed academically this year.
