SCHOOL BEGINS with morning prayers! Please be signed in no later than 8:05 a.m.

Students who are learning from home should be logging into ZOOM beginning at 8:00 a.m. so that they are ready for prayers. They should be in uniform and ready to begin their day with morning prayers. When prayers begin so does the school day. Each time a student arrives late to the Zoom, they cause distractions and interruptions for the entire school. Your child will be marked tardy if not on time for morning prayers. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

IMPORTANT REMINDER to CAR RIDERS!

Please be sure that whoever is picking up your children at the end of the school day has a LARGE SIGN with BOLD LETTERS placed in the front or side window of their vehicle. It must contain the last name of the student(s) being picked up. The signs are critical to the dismissal process as they help us safely and quickly place students in the vehicles. Please be sure to keep the large sign in your car window until your children enter the car.

IMPORTANT TECHNOLOGY USE FOR STUDENTS!

All of the school Chromebooks and devices are to be used strictly for school use only! Every student at SDSC uses Chromebooks at some point daily for learning. In addition, some of our students use these devices on their remote days at home. Please review the expectations of the Technology/Chromebook use agreement that was signed in the beginning of the school year with your child(ren). Both the child(ren) and parents/guardians are held to the expectations as noted in the Chromebook Use Policy & the Family Zoom Agreement. Both of these policies along with the Parent-Student Handbook are located on school website under "for Parents" tab for you to review at any time. In addition, it is important that whenever the student is using the Google Classroom or Zoom platforms for SDSC, that they are utilizing these tools properly and for school work only. The safety and well-being of the students is most important. This is critical, especially when our students are using technology. Please monitor your children's use of all technology (cell phones, chromebooks, i-pads, etc.) carefully - for their safety and well-being.
