SMART Tuition Accounts for 2020-21 School Year

SMART Tuition Accounts have been activated for the 2021-22 School Year for all fully enrolled students. Tutition is divided over a period of 11 months and the first tuition payment will be due July 15th. Early tuition bills will reflect the annual SMART \$40 admin fee, the \$60 technology fee, and a graduation fee for Grade 8 students. When you log into your SMART Tuition account, you should see all applicable Archdiocesan financial aid awards applied to your tuition. If you do not see awarded financial aid applied to your tuition, or if there is an error, please notify Mr. Krebs immediately so that your account can be corrected by the July 15th payment due date.

Summer Letters and Assignments

Summer assignments will include Summer Boost Assignments in both ELA and Math and will be assigned in their individual **IXL account**.
